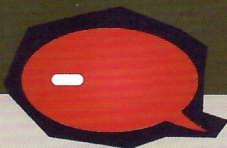

BUS SHUTTLES

FREE DAY- AND NIGHTTIME SHUTTLES

There will be two daytime shuttle on Saturday and Sunday at **11:00** and **13:00** and on Monday morning at **10:00**, bringing you from your partner hotel to the E Werk.

The nighttime shuttle will depart every night at the easy to remember times **1:00, 2:00, 3:00 and 4:00** directly from the E Werk and will service all partner hotels. On Sunday night there are also shuttles departing at **2:30, 3:30 and 5:00**.

If you need to get back home outside the shuttle times, you can always use public transport by day or get a cab at night. The infodesk will be happy to assist you.

AIRPORT SHUTTLES

If you have registered for a shuttle, you can buy your return ticket at the infodesk.

NETWORK SETTINGS

To connect your computer to the party network, just plug it into the switch at your table or connect to our wireless LAN.

No password is required. Keep in mind this also means your Wireless traffic is not encrypted. Make sure you use safe protocols to access your data (e.g. your email).
